The Payability Guide has been developed by PHS and the New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (NYCDOHMH) to provide guidance on submitting data for performance-based contracts.

The Guide brings together the most pertinent information about services & data reporting for all contracts. The major emphasis of the guide is the requirements for payment, but it also covers certain requirements for contract compliance.

The following are updates to the Payability Guide for May 2018:

- For the service categories **Harm Reduction Services (HRM)** and **Mental Health Services (MHV)**, the rule that a Care Coordination – Primary Care Provider service (code 247) is only payable once per 90 days has been removed.
- For the service category **Harm Reduction Services (HRM)**, the following service type has been added:
 - Health Education – Group (code Q20)
- For the service category **Food Nutrition Services (FNS)**:
 - A rule has been changed. No more than 21 Congregate Meals, Home Delivered Meals, and Pantry Bag Distribution (codes P46, 046, and 066) per index client are payable per week.
 - The service type Verification with HIV Primary Care Provider (code 247) has been removed.
- For the service categories **Supportive Counseling & Family Stabilization Services – General (SCG)** and **Supportive Counseling & Family Stabilization Services – SEP (SCI)**, a new service was added:
 - Pastoral Counseling – Family (code P75)
- For the service category **Legal Services (LSN/LST)**, Group Legal Services/Workshops (code N79) has been changed from an anonymous service paid per attendee to an anonymous service paid by the event.
- For the service category **HIV Testing and Status – Neutral Prevention and Care Navigation in Brooklyn (BTP)**, units for an STI Screening (code P65) will be calculated based on how many infections are tested for in a given service.
